DISCUSSION for GROUPS/FAMILIES

1. Read Nehemiah 9 then spend some time recapping what you heard Sunday – what stood out to you?
2. What are some things that bring you distress?
3. Name some things we have a tendency to turn to, other than God, in our times of distress?
4. Discuss some reasons why it is important to turn to God in times of distress and sin.
5. What are some of the ways you could describe God based on Nehemiah 9?
6. What are some of the ways you could describe the people based on Nehemiah 9?
7. What is your initial response to the statement “we are worse than we think?” Explain your response.
8. Discuss how believing this to be true actually leads us to good news.
9. Verse 26 tells us the people “cast your law behind their back.” What are some reasons we might put God’s word behind our back and ignore it?
10. When the word exposes our sin and disobedience, what does Nehemiah 9 teach us is the proper response?
11. Why is it a good thing to confess our sins to others and God?
12. Close your time by repeating the memory verse.
